For all dives, you'll need your own gear, a dive flag, and goodie bags. Mesh bags, work gloves, and lift bags are helpful if you have them. Divers need to be certified and capable of diving in the lake conditions. Please print a waiver and bring it with you to the May meeting or dive site. We can help you

find a buddy.

Avoid diving under other people's floats to avoid having something heavy dropped on your head. Be careful about boat traffic.
